Scarf Knitting Pattern

On the last page of this newsletter is the lace and fans pattern that we watched Tracey make into a scarf for a friend during past Tuesday night meetings. She has kindly submitted the pattern as many attendees requested.

Recipes

By popular request, Malin has sent in her chocolate tart recipe that was a big hit at one of our December potlucks.

Black Hound Tart

Make a pastry dough crust for 9" tart pan with a removable bottom. (I use a refrigerated ready-made crust since I don't make a pastry dough) often enough to do it well)

Preheat oven to 350

Pecan filling:

5 Tbsp unsalted butter 1/2c lightly packed brown sugar 3 Tbsp honey 2 Tbsp granulated sugar 2 tsp vanilla 1 1/2 Tbsp heavy cream 2 c pecan halves

Combine the butter, sugars and honey in a saucepan and cook over medium-high heat stirring occasionally until it's smooth and comes to a boil. Reduce heat to medium and simmer 2 minutes. Remove pan from heat and stir in cream and vanilla until blended. Mix in pecans until well coated. Spread in tart pan and bake 30-35 minutes until filling is bubbling all over and the pastry is golden brown. Cool completely.

Chocolate:

8 oz semisweet chocolate, finely chopped 3/4 c heavy cream 2 Tbsp light corn syrup 1 tsp vanilla

In a small saucepan, combine cream and corn syrup and cook over medium heat until it comes to a boil. Pour over the chocolate and let stand a few minutes to melt, then gently whisk to smooth. Stir in vanilla. Pour the glaze over the tart and spead in an even layer. Chill until the glaze is set.



PATTERN STITCHES

MOSS STITCH




Multiple of 2 sts. **Row 1** (Right side): (K1, P1) across. **Row 2:** (K1, P1) across.

Row 3: (P1, K1) across. **Row 4:** (P1, K1) across. Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern.



Multiple of 5 sts. **Row 1** (Right side): Knit across. **Row 2:** (K1, P4) across. **Rows 3 and 4:** (K3, P2) across. **Row 5:** (K1, P4) across. **Rows 6 and 7:** Knit across. **Rows 6 and 7:** Knit across. Repeat Rows 2-7 for pattern.

LACE AND FANS



Multiple of 15 sts + 1. **Row 1** (Right side): K1, YO (*Fig. 7a, page 33*), K1, P4, P2 tog twice (*Fig. 9, page 33*), P4, K1, ★ (YO, K1) twice, P4, P2 tog twice, P4, K1; repeat from ★ across to last st, YO, K1.

Row 2: Purl across.

Row 3: K1, ★ YO, K2, P3, P2 tog twice, P3, K2, YO, K1; repeat from ★ across.

Row 4: Purl across.

Row 5: K1, \star YO, K3, P2, P2 tog twice, P2, K3, YO, K1; repeat from \star across.

Row 6: Purl across.

Row 7: K1, ★ YO, K4, P1, P2 bog twice, P1, K4, YO, K1; repeat from ★ across.

Row 8: Purl across.

Row 9: K1, \star YO, K5, P2 to twice, K5, YO, K1; repeat from \star across.

Row 10: Purl across. Repeat Rows 1-10 for pattern. Multi Row if to 33), YO, Row Repe SIX
