Apple Butter Old Fashioned

Ingredients

- Coarse sugar, for the rim (optional)
- 1/4 cup apple cider
- Juice from 1/2 a lemon
- Dash of orange bitters
- 1 tablespoon apple butter
- 2 ounces bourbon
- Ginger beer or ginger kombucha, for topping
- Thinly sliced apples and cinnamon, for garnish

Instructions

- 1. If desired, rim your glass with coarse sugar.
- 2. In a cocktail shaker, combine the apple cider, lemon juice, orange bitters, apple butter, and bourbon. Shake to combine.
- 3. Strain into your prepared glass filled with ice. If desired, top with ginger beer. Garnish with cinnamon and apples. DRINK!
