ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Valley Fiber Arts Guild, hereinafter referred to as the Guild.

#### ARTICLE 11

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE III

The Guild is created for the purpose of providing educational and cultural enrichment for the community and State by promoting a greater interest in fiber arts and stimulating the individual craftsmen in these arts. Its objectives include, but are not limited to, the sponsorship of educational programs and events to further the objectives and purposes of the Guild, and the promotion and displaying of exhibits. The Guild is organized exclusively for educational and cultural purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

#### ARTICLE IV

Mo part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to the corporation), and no member, director, or officer of the corporation shall receive or benefit from any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE V

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation is shall not conduct ar carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by any organization except ander Section 601 might be required as Revenu Code and its regulations in whey now exist or as they are hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to affect are tedal to be action 170(c)(2) of such tests and regulations as they now exist or as they now exist or as they now exist or as they now bereafter be amended.

#### FRTICLE VI

Upon dissolution of the corporation or upon the conclusion of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to such charitable, scientific, or educational organization carrying on functions consistent with the purposes of this corporation which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

#### ARTICLE VII

The registered office of the corporation shall be SRA Box 6408, Wasilla, Alaska 99687, and the registered agent shall be Louise Carswell.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The Board of Directors of the corporation are expressly authorized to frame and adopt any such by-laws for the corporation as are not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Alaska or with these Articles. Any by-law so adopted by the Board of Directors of the corporation may be amended or repealed by a majority vote of a quorum of the voting members of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE IX

The corporation reserves the right to amend, add to, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in a manner consistent with the 'aw.
